II. Water

- * Definition: a transparent, odorless, tasteless liquid, a compound of hydrogen and oxygen, H₂ O, freezing at 32°F or 0°C and boiling at 212°F or 100°C, that in a more or less impure state constitutes rain, oceans, lakes, rivers, etc.:
 - **A.** Necessity for life to exist!
 - **B.** Water / liquid, ice / solid, & vapor / invisible (gaseous state)
 - **C.** It covers nearly 71 percent of Earth's surface.
 - **D.** Water moves constantly. Evaporation, Precipitation, and run off.
- * Water is referred to frequently in Scripture.

 - 1. <u>Isa. 44:3</u> pour out water on you and your decendants.
 - 2. Prov. 1:23 Turn at my rebuke and I will pour out my Spirit.
